

# Exploring Christianity Study 5

## What Is Faith?

---

### Introduction

We discovered in the previous studies that all mankind are sinners, because they fall short of God's perfect standard. As a result of his sinful state, man is under God's just condemnation and anger. In this sinful state, no person can enter Heaven. We learned that repentance is a change of heart toward God, which leads to a change in direction. True repentance will be encouraged by considering what Jesus Christ has done in His suffering for your sins. Have you prayed for God's help before starting this study?

### Section 1 — What is Bible Faith?

Remember our only source of guidance is the Bible. Read Hebrews 11:1.

Faith is the \_\_\_\_\_ of things hoped for, the \_\_\_\_\_ of things not seen.

This is the nearest thing we find in the Bible to a definition of faith. A person who has faith about certain things has a conviction in their hearts that these things promised in the Bible are true, even though they do not see them yet. The person who has faith is trusting God to carry out His promises. True Bible faith is to believe the promises of God and to rely on them. God is utterly trustworthy and we can be confident in His promises.

### Section 2 — Faith Illustrated by Abel. Read Genesis 4:1-5.

Consider Noah's situation. He was on dry land, probably a long way from any body of water, and God told him to build a boat. There was no obvious need for it, because there was no water to float it on! But Noah acted in faith. He trusted God's promise about what God was going to do in judging the world. Noah would have definitely received much mocking from the faithless crowd, who would no doubt have gathered to watch this strange sight. Yet he continued the ship building work, convinced that God would keep His promise. He warned everyone else about the coming disaster. They could have prepared for it if they had wished, or even found space on Noah's boat (see 2 Peter 2:5).

#### **Section 4** — Faith Illustrated Further by Abraham. Read Genesis 18:9-14 and Romans 4:18-21.

#### **Section 6** — True Biblical Faith Is An Absolute Necessity.

Some people feel that faith is an optional extra, but this is not true. Consider Hebrews 11:6.

What can you not do without faith? You cannot \_\_\_\_\_ God without faith.

Faith is vital to pleasing God. Do you wish to please God? You cannot please God without true Bible type faith.

Therefore true faith is the starting point for any life that really pleases God.

If you cannot point to such a definite occasion, then it is likely that you are not saved.

Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
